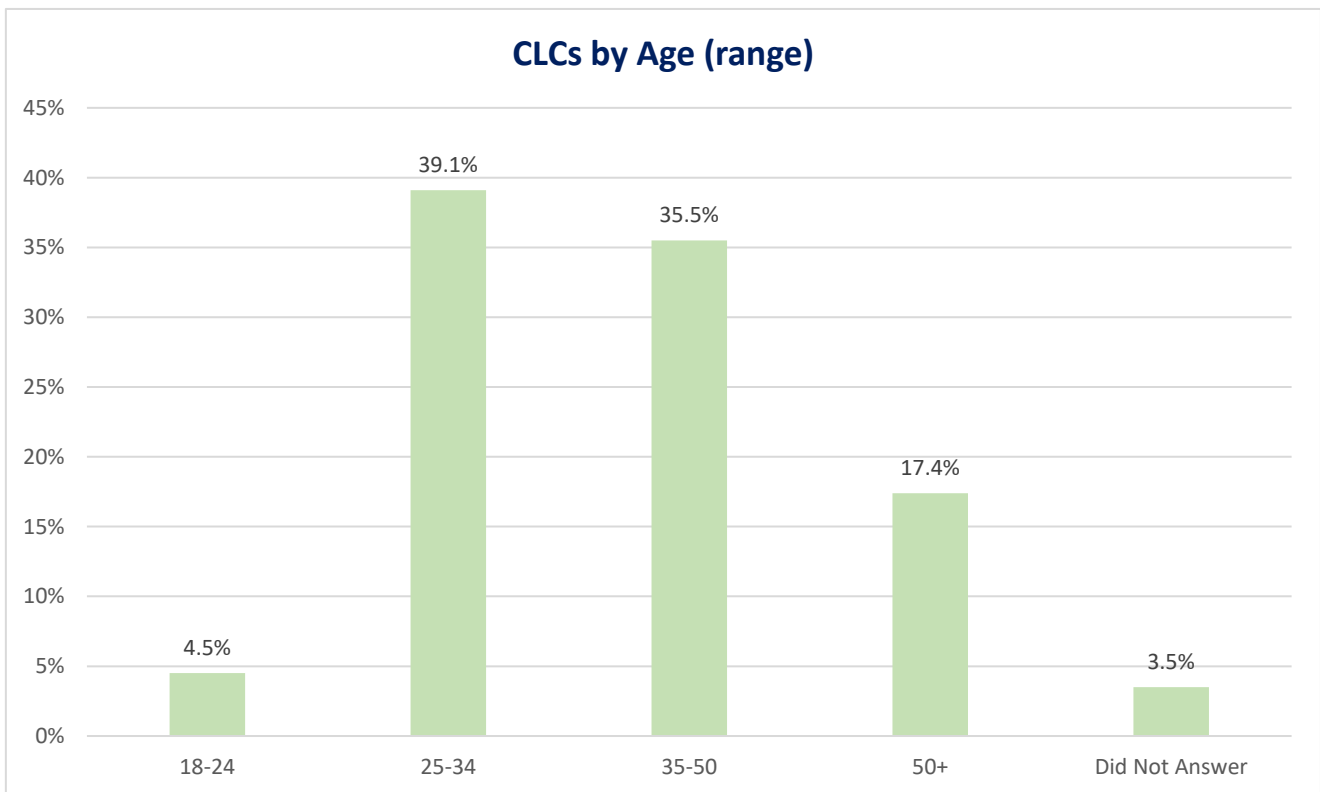
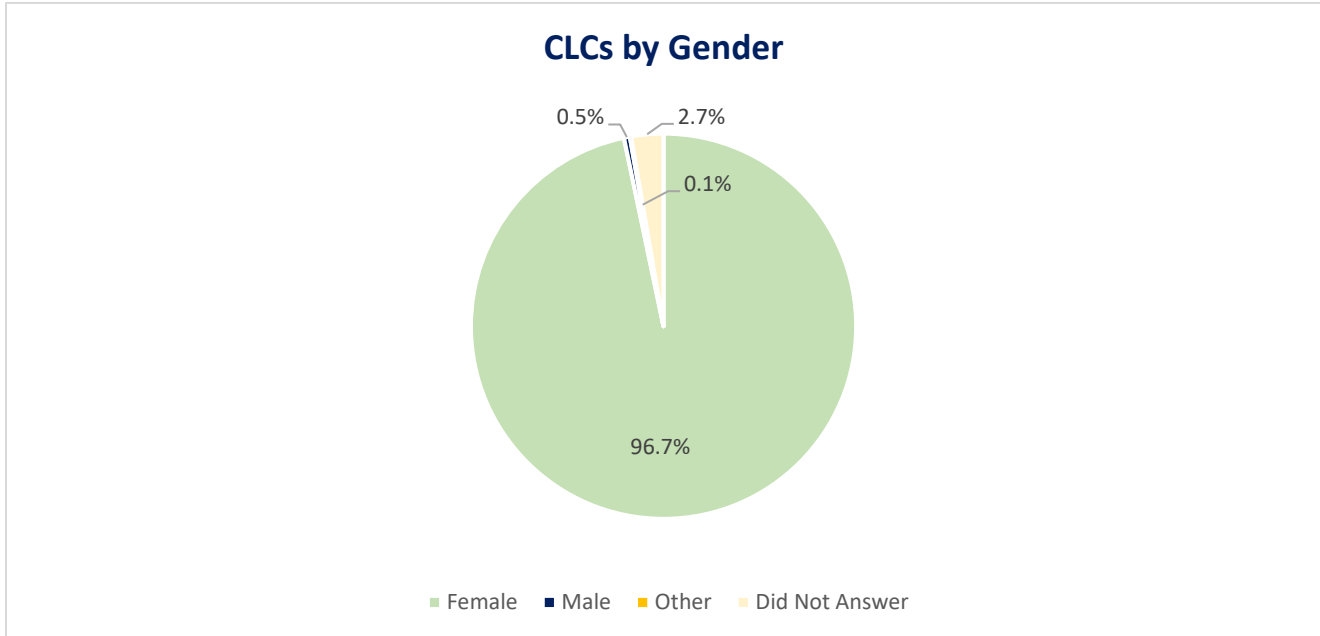


## Demographic Report of current CLCs in the U.S. & Territories\*

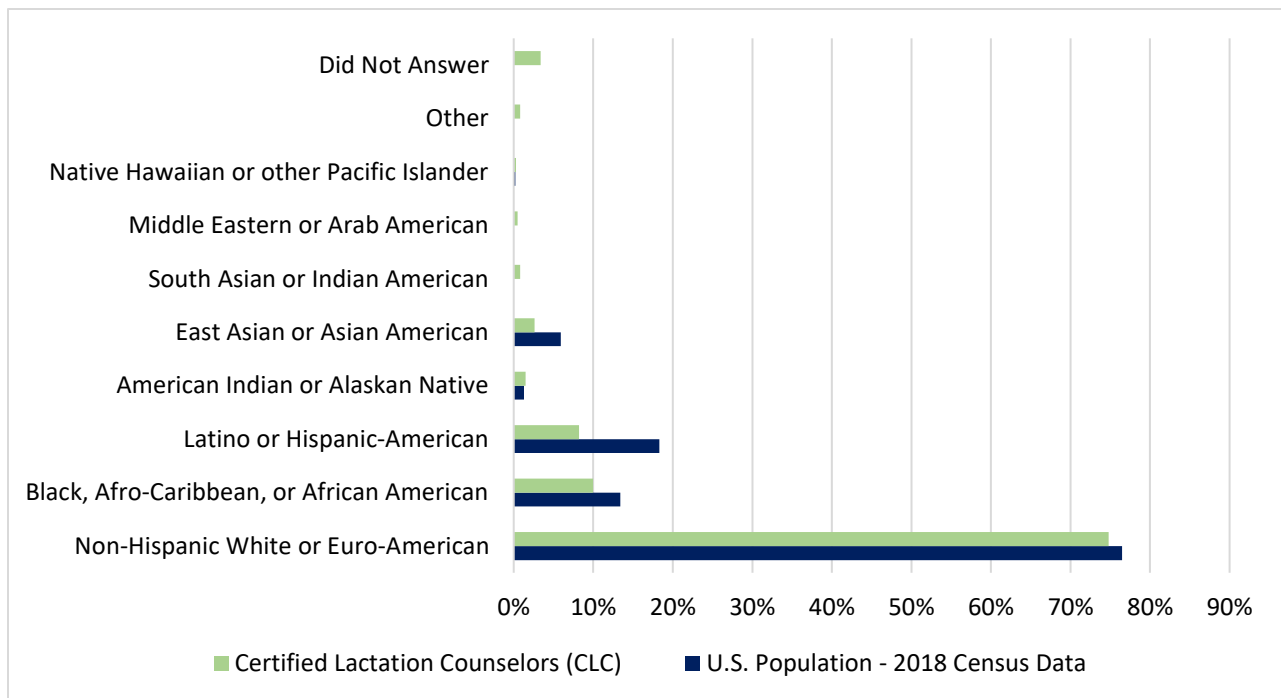

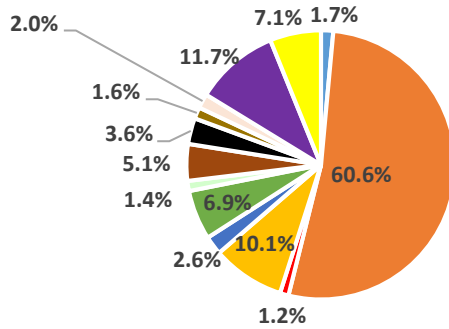

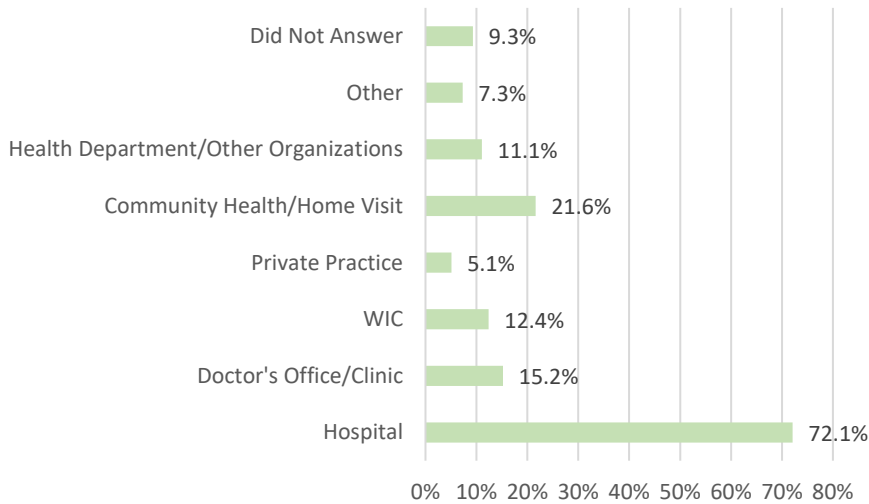
